Cammie Patch Scholarship Guidelines



Entry Rules:

- Idaho Resident
- 17 years or older
- Awarded applicant must be able to purchase a \$1000 GCA Student Pilot PPL Kit.
- Awarded applicant must obtain a 3rd class medical prior to the commencement of flight training
- Awarded applicant will be required to pay any third-party expenses such as knowledge test and practical test fees.
- Awarded applicant will have their private pilot knowledge test completed by thirty (30) flight hours or there will be an hourly charge per flight hour after thirty (30) hours, until the knowledge test is completed and passed. Scholarship hours will resume after the private pilot knowledge test is completed and passed.

Amount: \$12,000.00

Application Procedure:

The application packet should include at least the following items:

- Essay including aviation interests, goals, how you plan to continue to pursue flight training outside of the opportunity provided by this scholarship, and financial need
- Current resume
- At least two Letters of Recommendation
- Completed applications should be submitted via the GCA Scholarship Website

Terms:

- Applications will be accepted until midnight of July 15th, 2024.
- Winner will be notified by July 22nd, 2024.
- The one year scholarship will be awarded when approved by the committee and the funds will be deposited in the student's GCA account. This is a non monetary award, and must be used at GCA. Any unused funds at the end of the year will revert to the GCA scholarship fund.
- Applicants will be asked to submit a short biography and photo to share on the GCA website. Applicants give GCA the right to use information on social media.
- Applicants will be evaluated at the sole discretion of the GCA scholarship committee.

Deadline: Applications must be submitted no later than midnight June 15th, 2024.
